About Ya Bana:

YA BANAis registered as a Child and Youth Care Centre (CHILDREN'S HOME) in terms of Section 200 of the CHILDREN'S ACT (Act No. 38 of 2005).

YA BANA.... is also registered as a non-profit organization in terms of the Non-profit Organization Act, 1997 (079-399NPO).

YA BANA... is a NONPROFIT COMPANY, duly registered and incorporated in terms of the Companies Act, 1973 (Reg. No. 2006/018471/08).

YA BANA VILLAGE.... is located in the heart of the Winterveld on an 8 hectares piece of land registered in Ya Bana's name.

Our Village is surrounded by a community which still finds it difficult to cast off the shackles of poverty.

Presently Ya Bana cares for 30 orphaned and vulnerable children on a full-time basis in 5 **Foster Care Houses** which were constructed and furnished over a period of 4 years at a cost of approximately R350 000 per house.







Each house is managed by a carefully selected and properly trained house mother (single parent.) These mothers live in the houses and care for the children of Ya Bana as if they were their own.



During 2013, Ya Bana constructed and furnished a **Youth Living Centres** at a cost of R 900 000. These centres provide accommodation to school leavers while they receive skills training prior to obtaining full time employment.



Over the past 4 years, Ya Bana also constructed an **Early Learning Centre**, consisting of 6 classrooms, storerooms, bathrooms, kitchen and playgrounds for pre-school children. These facilities were constructed at a cost of approximately R 1 500 000 and the school is attended by approximately 165 children from Ya Bana and the surrounding community. School fees are levied at a rate of R100 per month only, applying a means test.





The **Operational Costs** in respect of the entire Village (houses, staff salaries, teacher salaries, social worker, medical services, laundry, food (we prepare and serve more than 2000 meals per week!), clothing, security, transport, garden, excursions, school fees and uniforms, etc. amount to approximately R150 000 per month and it remains YA BANA'S biggest challenge to raise this amount month after month.
